

**ITEC Diploma in Laser & Intense Pulsed Light Treatment (International Accreditation)**



To complete the ITEC diploma students have to complete both courses - for Hair Reduction and Skin Rejuvenation.

Following completion of both courses further assessment is required to gain the ITEC qualification. You will need to sit an ITEC theory paper, have a practical assessment by an outside ITEC examiner and will need to complete further case studies in your workplace.

The ITEC examination will be held twice a year, for dates please contact the office.

There will be an additional fee to cover the ITEC examiner and assessment fees.

- WRBCS409A Apply knowledge of skin science to beauty therapy treatments
- WRBCS410A Apply knowledge of electricity to beauty therapy treatments
- WRBCS411A Apply knowledge of nutrition to beauty therapy treatments
