Course Pre-requisite Units

The courses in Intense Pulsed Light Therapy are direct entry programs although it is a requirement that participants have as a minimum the following competencies from the Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy (WRB40105) or equivalent, (e.g. Medical Practitioner, or Nursing Qualification), plus a minimum of 12 months practical experience.

Units required:

- WRBCS305A Apply knowledge of skin biology to beauty treatments
- WRBCS408A Apply knowledge of anatomy and physiology to beauty treatments
- WRBCS409A Apply knowledge of skin science to beauty therapy treatments
- WRBCS410A Apply knowledge of electricity to beauty therapy treatments
- WRBCS411A Apply knowledge of nutrition to beauty therapy treatments

Completing units via correspondence:

For anyone without a background in beauty therapy it is still possible to do the course in IPL if they first complete the units required. The units are theory based and require the student to complete assignments. We will assess the assignments and issue a "Statement of Attainment" from the National Beauty Training Package.

The cost to complete these units is \$190 per unit, a total of \$950.00

To complete the units successfully we will supply all assignments, some learning material and we recommend the purchase of the "Beauty Therapy Fact File" (\$95.00), a textbook book for anyone training to be a Beauty Therapist. This also contains handy practical hints for when you work as an IPL operator. Most students use the internet as a resource however we do have a recommended book list as well.

After completing the IPL course you will receive a Certificate of Attendance and once you have had twelve months practical experience I am able to issue the Government Qualification. Please let me know if you have any further questions.
